



ProjectWise - Registering the WSDOT ProjectWise Server

Overview

Access through ProjectWise Explorer requires that you register the WSDOT ProjectWise Server as explained below.

To manually register the server information:

- 1. Open the Bentley ProjectWise Explorer. (Alternatively, *Control Panel > ProjectWise Network* will open the ProjectWise Network Configuration Settings dialog outside the application)
- 2. Select the *Tools > Network Configuration Settings…* command. (This tool may trigger a Microsoft User Account Control [UAC] message accept to continue).
- 3. Select the <u>DNS Services</u> tab, and type in the following information:
 - Name **WSDOT** (or your naming convention)
 - Hostname Projectstore.wsdot.wa.gov
 - Port **5800**

- 4. Click **Add**, and **repeat** with the same information under the <u>Datasource Listing</u> tab
- 5. Click **Apply** and **OK**, and then restart the ProjectWise Explorer.
