The Washington State Department of Transportation's Adopt-a-Highway Program allows volunteers to enhance the appearance of Washington's state highways. Participants are advised that working adjacent to a state highway can be hazardous and shall exercise due care in performing litter pick up activities. Participants must receive safety training utilizing training aids furnished by the WSDOT prior to participating in any cleanup activities. Participants shall wear the vest furnished by WSDOT and have the supplied hard hat "on-site" ready for use if needed. Participants are entitled to receive full coverage for medical treatment necessitated by an injury incurred during participation in the Adopt-a-Highway Program under the Medical Aid Provisions of the Worker's Compensation Act, which is administered by the Department of Labor and Industries, but not for loss of time due to injury or illness or for lasting disability or death. By signature below I verify that I am a volunteer, 15 years of age or older, have viewed the Adopt-a-Highway Safety Video, and read the Adopt-a-Highway Safety Tips Brochure. I also understand the rights, responsibilities, and privileges of participation in the Adopt-a-Highway Program, and agree to hold harmless the Washington Department of Transportation and their employees from liability for damages or injury resulting from my participation in this program.
